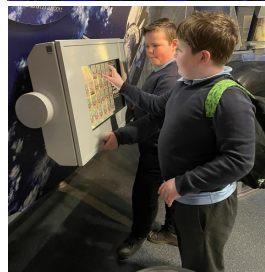
Our whole school attendance this week is 90%.

To support learning in their **Science** topic, **Earth and Space**, the Hive visited the National Space Museum in Leicester. What an amazing and enriching trip! Pupils enjoyed touring the exhibitions to revisit their learning in school. This included: the **movement of the moon relative to the Earth**, knowing that the **sun, moon and Earth** are spherical bodies, knowing that the Earth's **rotation** creates day and night and that the movements of the Earth and other planets are **relative to the sun** in the **solar system**. Highlights of the day included travelling to the top of the iconic **Rocket Tower**, home to Blue Streak and Thor Able rockets, to view a piece of the moon. The afternoon saw an amazing visit to the **planetarium** to take a virtual tour of the solar system. The Hive were curious and enthusiastic learners, and perfectly behaved. Well done to the Hive!
