### DATES TO REMEMBER

#### Dear Parents and Carers,

I want to update you on how governors have been working with the school over the last term. Governors approved a major investment in pupil toilets and this work has been carried out over the last few weeks. All toilets and sanitary facilities have been completely refurbished and the floors in the toilets renewed. These facilities have been redecorated and I expect the corridor in the Burrow to be repainted shortly. This will complete the project and governors believe that the refurbishment has significantly improved the physical environment for pupils.

Governors have continued to monitor the work of the school through their regular meetings; they recently attended a morning in school to attend classroom activities as well as talk to pupils about their learning. This was a very positive experience and governors were impressed with the progress made in implementing changes, for example in the teaching of maths, and to the curriculum more generally. It is a requirement for governors to keep abreast of educational developments and governors have taken relevant courses provided by the Council and the National College this term. These courses increasingly take place online.

I want to thank all staff, on behalf of governors, for their commitment and contributions to the work of the school this term and especially Mrs Armstrong for her work with the Burrow covering Ms Corcoran's maternity leave over the last two terms. I am also very pleased to welcome back Ms Corcoran to the staff team to work with Miss Taylor.

Finally, I wish all staff, parents and their children a very happy Easter break.
