It's getting to that time of year when we start thinking about September and school uniform. **Uniform Direct** have been in touch to let us know that

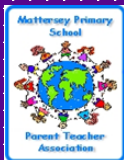
you can place online orders with **free delivery** above £29 **including exchanges** up to the start of the new academic year. Our uniform consists of:

- PE kit is a WHITE t-shirt (logo) and NAVY blue shorts/joggers
